

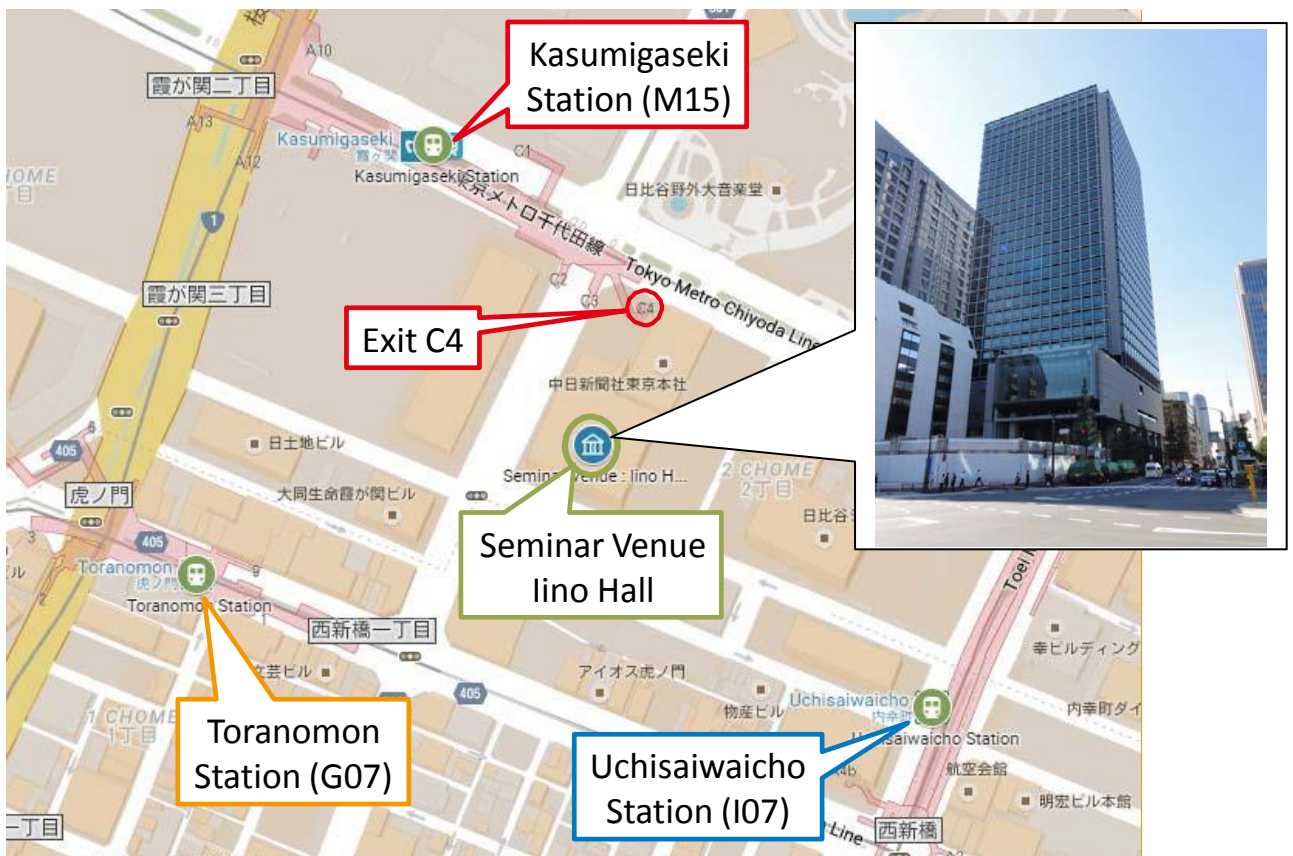

- Uchisaiwaicho Station Exit A7 (3-minute walk) Toei Subway: Mita Line



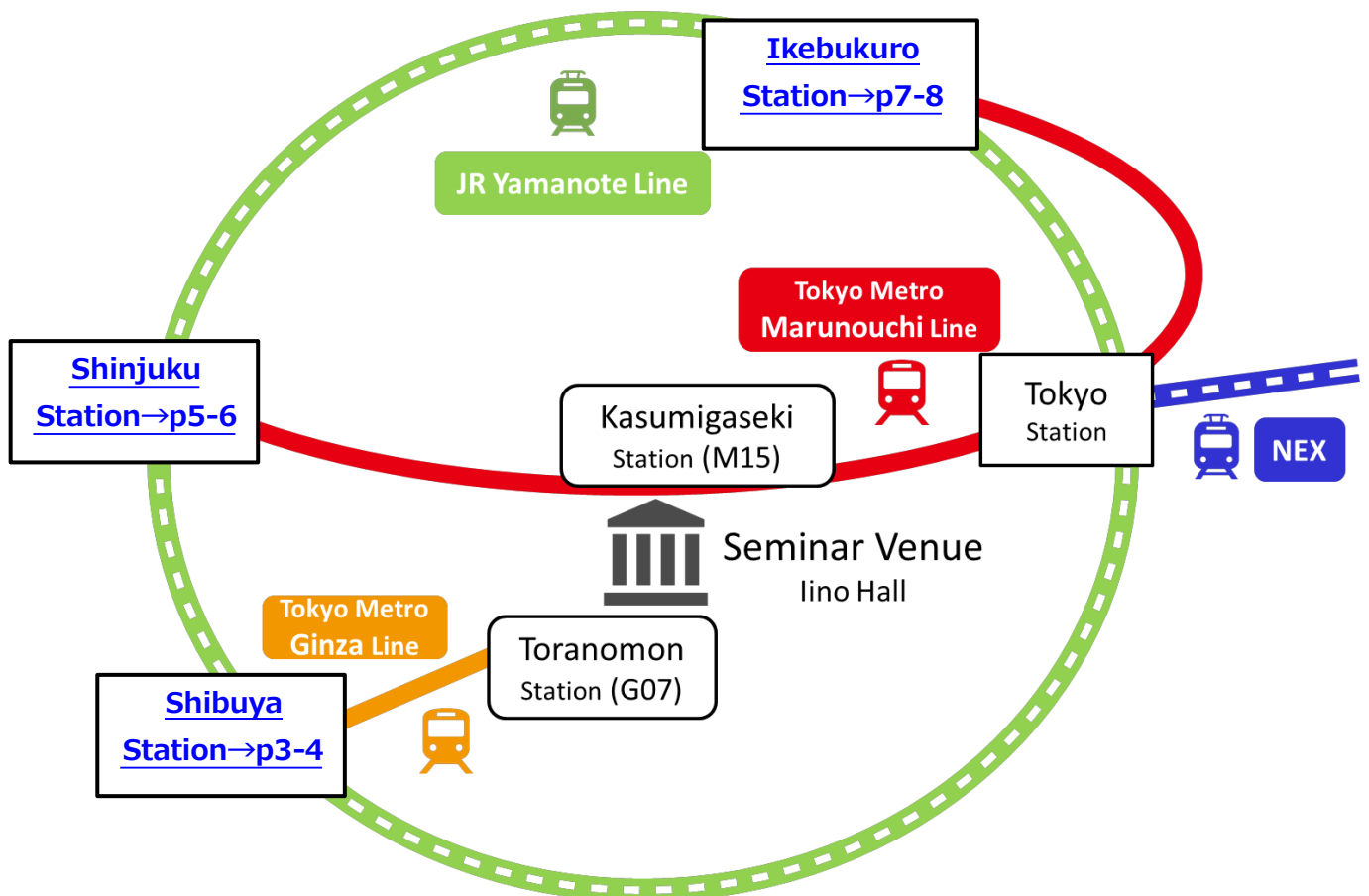

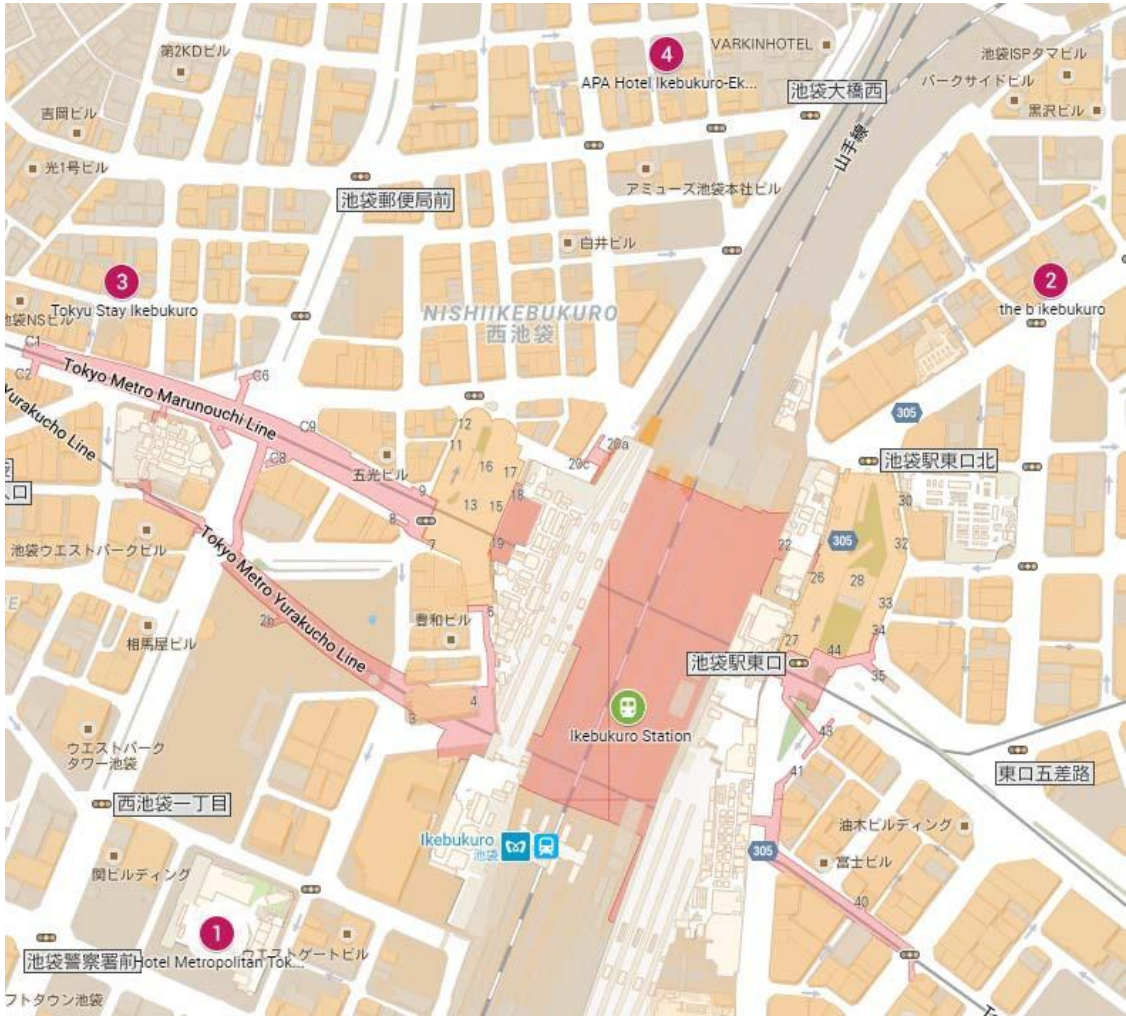

3-3. JR / Tokyo Metro

- To **Kasumigaseki Station** (one of the nearest station to the venue)
 - From **Narita Airport**

Take NEX and change trains to Marunouchi subway line bound for bound for Shinjuku, Ogikubo or Nakano-fujimicho at Tokyo Station. Get off at Kasumigaseki station. Train fare from Tokyo Station to Kasumigaseki station is 170 JPY.
 - From **Shinjuku Station**

Take Marunouchi line bound for Ikebukuro at Shinjuku station or Shinjuku-sanchome station. Get off at Kasumigaseki station. Train fare from Shinjuku station to Kasumigaseki station is 170 JPY.
 - From **Ikebukuro Station**

Take Marunouchi line bound for Shinjuku, Ogikubo or Nakano-fujimicho at Ikebukuro station. Get off at Kasumigaseki station. Train fare from Ikebukuro Station to Kasumigaseki station is 200 JPY.
- To **Toranomon Station** (another nearest station to the venue)
 - From **Shibuya Station**

Take Ginza line bound for Asakusa at Shibuya station. Get off at Toranomon station. Train fare from Shibuya station to Toranomon station is 170 JPY.

- From Narita To **Shibuya Station**

Take NEX and change trains to JR Yamanote line bound for Shibuya at Tokyo Station. Train fare from Tokyo Station to Akihabara Station is 200 JPY.

- From Narita To **Shinjuku Station**

Take NEX and change trains to Marunouchi line bound for Shinjuku, Ogikubo or Nakano-fujimicho at Tokyo Station. Train fare from Tokyo Station to Shinjuku Station is 200 JPY.

- From Narita To **Ikebukuro Station**

Take NEX and change trains to JR Yamanote line bound for Ikebukuro at Tokyo Station. Get off at Ikebukuro Station. Train fare from Tokyo Station to Ikebukuro Station is 200 JPY.

4. General Information on Japan

*We encourage you to exchange foreign currency for Japanese yen upon your arrival at the airport. If you forget or fail to exchange money in Narita or Haneda Airport, you will have to exchange them in the bank. Most banks can exchange money, but they are open Monday through Friday from 9:00 to 15:00, so it is highly advisable to exchange the money in Narita or Haneda Airport.

- **Currency** : Japanese Yen only (Foreign currency is NOT accepted)
- **Time zone** : GMT +9
- **Electricity** : 100 volts
- **Electric Plug Details** : USA/Japan type A
- **Telephone country code** : +81
- **Credit Cards** : Worldwide-recognized credit cards are mostly accepted: VISA, Master Card, Diners Club, and the American Express are widely accepted at department stores, shops, restaurants and so on.
- **Average Temperature in February** : 10/3 °C (high/low)
- **Mobile phone** : Internet roaming service is available.

- You can find rental mobile phone / WiFi in the Tokyo International Airport (Narita/ Haneda).
